The pirate community, made up of many religions, races and nationalities, was packed with superstitions and legends.

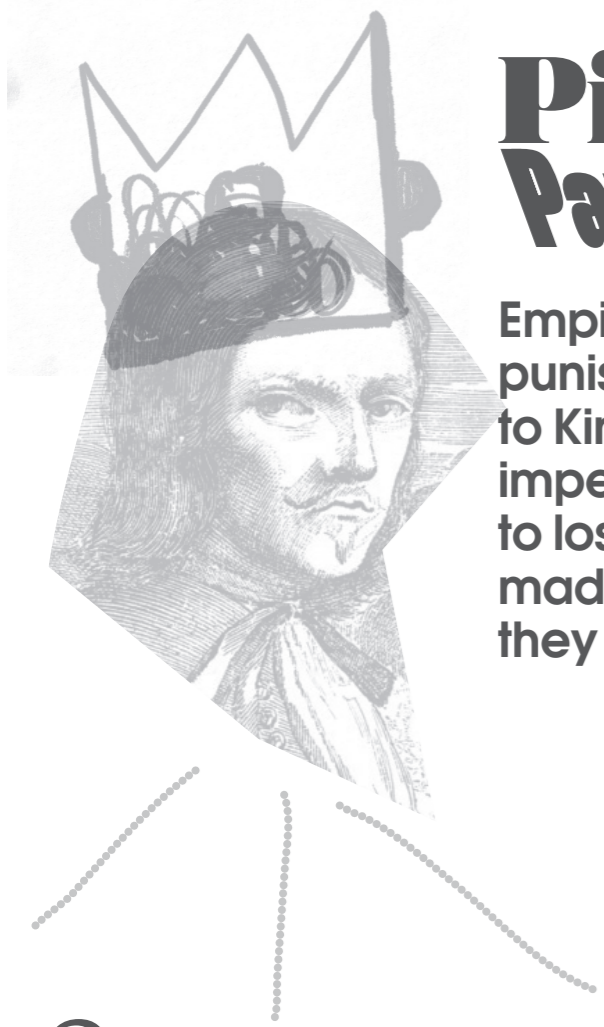

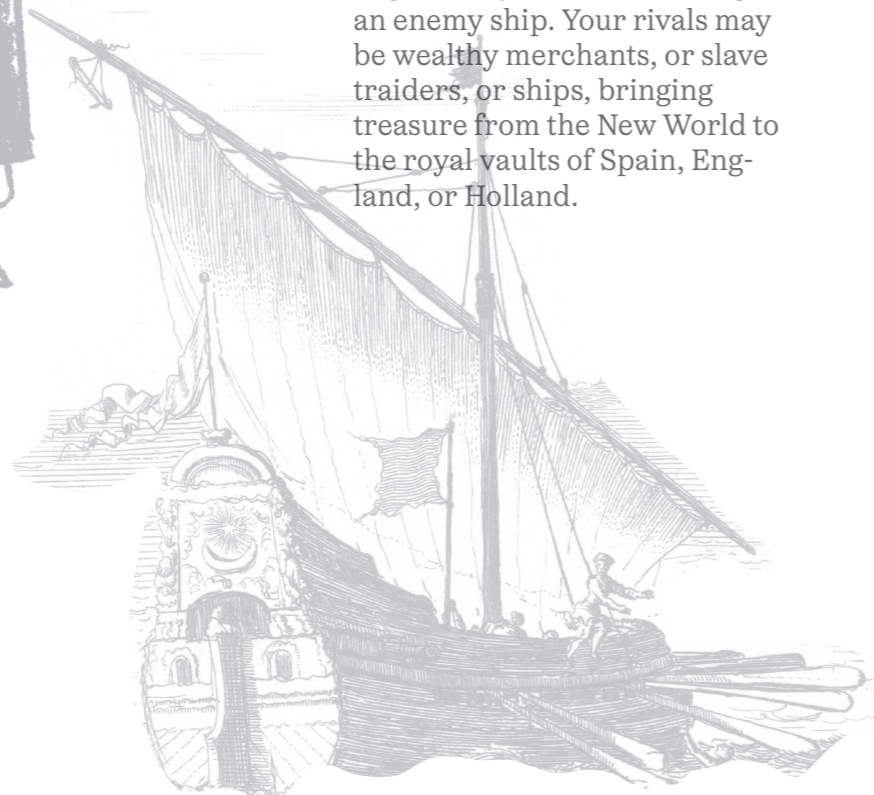
Pirate Flag
